Grow Your Mindset

Remember the feedback we give the children in class can either reinforce a Fixed Mind-set or Growth Mind-set belief and focus.

Avoid language that reinforces ego based feedback,
‘That’s brilliant’, ‘You finished that quickly!’
Or language that emphasises low expectations,
‘That seems too hard, lets try this instead’.

Focus on language that promotes a Growth Mindset linked to the learning blocks, **feedback, mistakes, challenges** and **effort**. Changing our language helps to develop the mind-sets of those we teach.
